Dr. Andrew Peterson joined the faculty at Duke in 2010 after serving 23 years in the United States Army. He serves as the Vice Chief of Medical Operations, the Urology Residency Program Director, and directs the Reconstructive Urology and Genitourinary Cancer Survivor Fellowship. The Fellowship was established in 2013 and has grown into a worldwide program with research devoted to helping cancer patients and their families with their struggles through surgeries, life adjustments, and the challenges they face in living a normal life as a cancer survivor.

Duke Urology is a world leader in compassionate, transformational urologic care for all patients with a mission statement that reads, "Advancing urologic health as a leader in world class multi-disciplinary research; transformative education; and compassionate, innovative and exceptional urologic care for all patients."

Brick Landing resident, Bobby Jones, a cancer survivor, was a patient of Dr. Drew Peterson. Together they fought to give Bobby a better quality of life and the two men became friends. Monica Jones shares, "Dr. Peterson is extremely dedicated to his work and patients, but at the same time he is the guy you just want to go out with and have a beer." The Jones family established the [Cancer: Surviving and Thriving Golf Tournament](#) in 2020 raising funds to support the Fellowship. Founded by Kara Kenan and Joy Wade, "Beyond the Pink", is a non-profit community center in Wilmington offering services to women in Brunswick County and several area counties.

Started in 2017 by Kara and Joy, their Center offers comprehensive education, financial assistance and resources on breast health before, during, and after a cancer diagnosis. *Going Beyond the Pink's* mission is to empower breast cancer patients and survivors with knowledge and support so they can thrive through treatment into survivorship. They envision a world where everyone affected by breast cancer is connected, empowered, resilient, informed, and have the support and resources they need to thrive through treatment and into survivorship. Empowering breast cancer patients and survivors to thrive beyond the fear and uncertainty of a breast cancer diagnosis, they go beyond the pink ribbons. "I never say Cancer is a gift . . . it is hell!" but Kara's fight lead her and Joy to work together to help others with breast cancer. They found lots of people don't seek help because they're overwhelmed or scared. Beyond the Pink not only connects patients with local resources and community experts but also adds support with their "Thrive" program offering traditional, alternative and supplemental wellness and survivorship curriculum to nourish the mind, body and spirit.

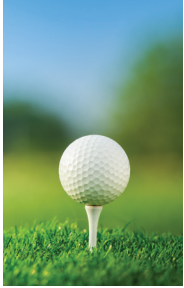
