Dr. Andrew Peterson joined the faculty at Duke in 2010 after serving 23 years in the United States Army. He serves as the Vice Chief of Medical Operations, the Urology Residency Program Director, and directs the Reconstructive Urology and Genitourinary Cancer Survivor Fellowship. The Fellowship was established in 2013 and has grown into a worldwide program with research devoted to helping cancer patients and their families with their struggles through surgeries, life adjustments, and the challenges they face in living a normal life as a cancer survivor.

Duke Urology is a world leader in compassionate, transformational urologic care for all patients with a mission statement that reads, "Advancing urologic health as a leader in world class multi-disciplinary research; transformative education; and compassionate, innovative and exceptional urologic care for all patients."

Brick Landing resident, Bobby Jones, a cancer survivor, was a patient of Dr. Drew Peterson. Together they fought to give Bobby a better quality of life and the two men became friends. Monica Jones shares, "Dr. Peterson is extremely dedicated to his work and patients, but at the same time he is the guy you just want to go out with and have a beer." The Jones family established the Cancer: Surviving and Thriving Golf Tournament in 2020 raising funds to support the Fellowship.
